

## **Disciplinary Complaint Resolution Agreement**

Made under the Authority of section 55(2)(a.l) of the Health Professions Act

Between:

## **Sukdeep Grewal**

(the "Investigated Person")

and

## **Alberta College of Dental Hygienists**

(the "College")

A Disciplinary Complaint Resolution Agreement (DCRA) was entered into between the Investigated Person and the College, dated February 3, 2024.

Sukdeep Grewal, a former regulated member with the ACDH (the Investigated Person), acknowledged and admitted that his behaviour constituted unprofessional conduct. The Investigated Person acknowledged and admitted that from August 26, 2023 to August 31, 2023, he engaged in unprofessional conduct arising from 2 complaints to the College.

The Investigated Person acknowledged and admitted that he failed to act professionally, failed to respect professional boundaries and failed to protect personal information of a patient, in that he:

- 1. Removed personal information of a patient from a dental practice with the intention to contact the patient to ask her to go out with him.
- 2. Contacted the patient by phone and text to ask the patient out for dinner.
- 3. Knew or should have known that his contact with the patient would be unwelcomed and would adversely affect the patient's health and well-being including her sense of personal safety.

The Investigated Person cancelled his registration with the College on October 31, 2023. He agreed that in the event he reapplies for registration and a practice permit with the College and the registrar finds he satisfies the requirements of registration and is eligible for registration and a practice permit, he will be immediately suspended for 2 weeks and must pay a fine of \$1,000.
